

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING OF AUGUST 30, 2022

The Board of County Commissioners of Chippewa County, Minnesota, met in special session on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 at 8:30 a.m. in the Courthouse in Montevideo, Minnesota. Commissioners present were Matt Gilbertson, Bill Pauling, Candice Jaenisch, David Lieser, and David Nordaune. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the 2023 budget and levy for Chippewa County.

Commissioner Lieser called the meeting to order and requested any changes to the agenda. Commissioner Gilbertson moved, second by Commissioner Jaenisch to approve the agenda. The motion passed by a unanimous vote.

Family Services Director Lisa Schultz and Fiscal Supervisor Jennifer Kolp presented the proposed 2023 budget and levy for Family Services.

County Engineer Jeremy Gilb presented the 2023 proposed 2023 budget and levy for Highway Department.

Auditor/Treasurer/Coordinator Michelle May and Sr. Deputy Auditor/Treasurer Amanda Duenow presented the 2023 budget and levy for the General Fund and county-wide.

No action was taken on the 2023 budget and levy.

Motion by Commissioner Gilbertson, second by Commissioner Nordaune to close the public meeting under MN Statute 13D.05 subd. 3 to discuss the appraisal and price of property under parcel 70-045-0410 and 70-375-1870. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Motion by Commissioner Nordaune, second by Commissioner Gilbertson to open the public meeting. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

Motion by Commissioner Nordaune, second by Commissioner Pauling to notify the owner of parcel 70-375-1870 with the County's intent to purchase contingent on negotiated price and contingencies to be agreed upon by both parties. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
